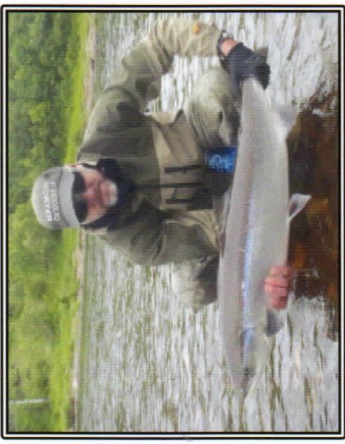


Atlantic Salmon Fly Fishing Only Seasons and Best Times

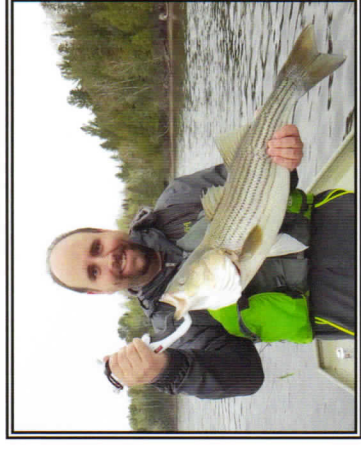
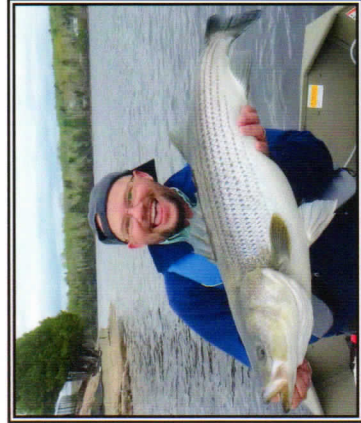
Season Opens April 15th thru October 15th

Good to Fair Depends on Temperatures and Flows

Atlantic Salmon at sea prefer temps 45- 58 Fahrenheit. In the rivers they will be most active between 53-59 degrees Fahrenheit and can remain very active until 70 degrees. As temperatures rise above 70 degrees, there will be a drastically noticeable decrease in the salmon's activity. Now they begin to search out cooler and more oxygenated water for survival, becoming lethargic and susceptible to easy death due to exhaustion and stress. Specific areas and even complete river systems can be restricted and even closed for a period of time until conditions improve. A bump in flows from rains and cooler weather is truly a savior for these wild fish.



Two Split Striped Bass Angling Seasons and Best Times

Spring Season May 1st thru June 30th Fall Season October 1st thru October 31st

Good to Fair Depends on Temperatures and Flows

Striped Bass are temperature sensitive are most active between 55 to 68 degrees Fahrenheit.

Any sudden drop in early spring temps may cause them to completely shut down until the water temps begin to rise.
